

C. Prerequisites for the physicians training

- The physician must have specialist status (orthopaedics/surgery) or at least 4 years surgical experience in an orthopaedic or surgical/traumatological hospital.
- He must have experience in performing and evaluating skeletal X-ray examinations and the skill to perform sonographic examinations of the musculoskeletal system.
 - Theoretical training in the physical principle of functioning of shockwaves.
 - Further training in the applications of extracorporeal shockwave therapy in diseases of the musculoskeletal system.
 - Further training in the various applications of high and low energy shockwaves
- Training in the use of the treatment device
- Administering of treatments for Epicondylitis, Tendinosis calcarea, Pseudarthrosis and Fasciitis plantaris under the supervision of an ESWT qualified physician. To fill the criteria a minimum of 20 sessions of the above mentioned treatment of the minimum of two from each category is required.
